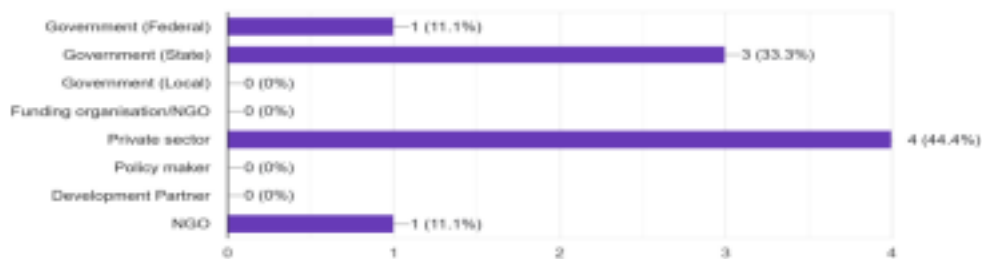

Which sector do you represent

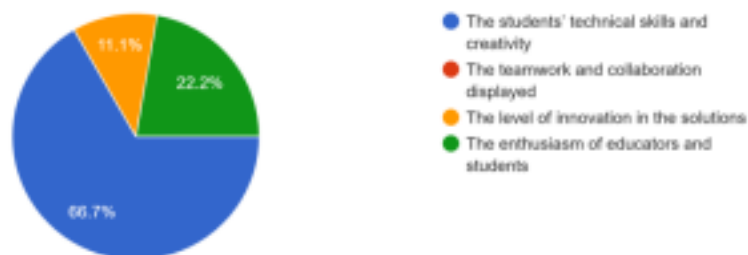

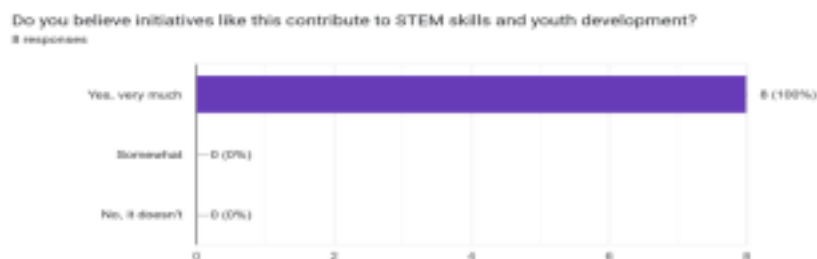
